

CHILD'S INTERNET USAGE CONTRACT

- 1. I will talk with my parent(s) about rules and guidelines for the computer and internet. I will then seek to honor God and my parents by my sincere obedience to their rules and guidelines.
- 2. I will make sure my parent(s) knows about the services and web sites I desire to use and seek their approval before using them. If my parents do not know how to use them, I will show them how.
- 3. I will never give out personal information such as my name, address, telephone number, my picture, parents' work address or telephone number, or the name and location of my school without my parents' permission.
- 4. I will not give out my internet password to anyone other than my parents (not even my best friends).
- 5. If someone my parents and I have never met in person contacts me online and requests to meet with me, I will immediately notify my parents without responding to the online person.
- 6. I will not respond to any messages that are mean or in any way make me feel uncomfortable. Instead, I will show my parents so they can contact the internet service provider.
